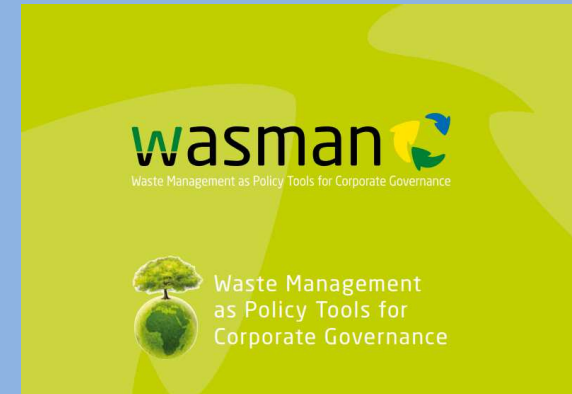
1. Established in 2004 with the aim to make Europe closer to our territory by:

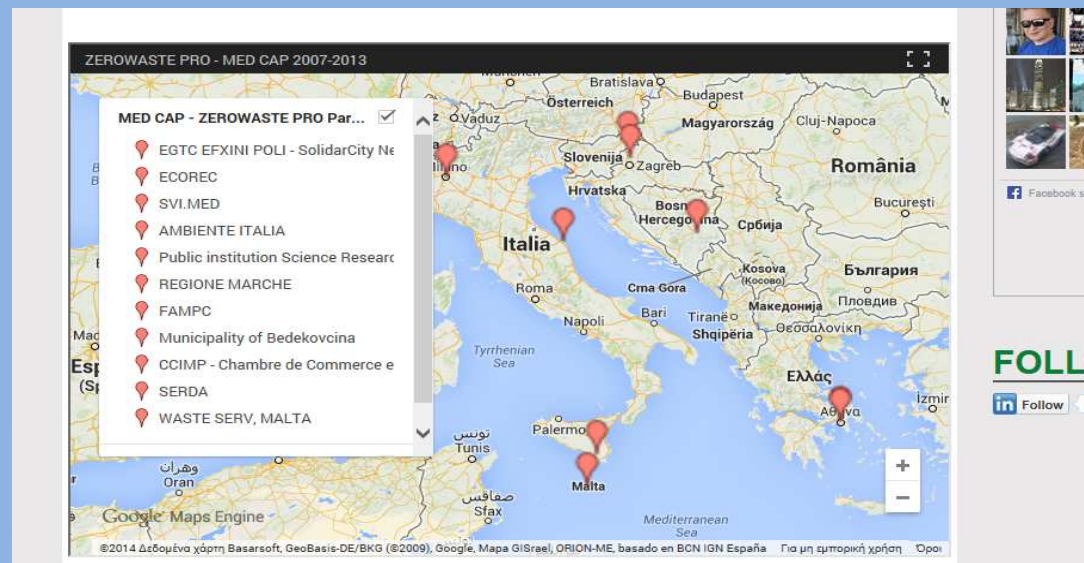
